1. Workplace Advice Line 13 29 59:

This is a complimentary service connecting you with Business NSW workplace experts who can provide confidential advice on a broad range of impacts in managing your staff.

The service includes up to 3 advice calls per year. Workplace advisors are in place to help you qualify your employer responsibilities and identify any gaps in knowledge or process that could inadvertently create a legal risk for your business. Typically, topics we assist with include leave entitlements, verifying wage rates to your award, termination of employment, Work, Health and Safety, Worker Compensation and discrimination and harassment. In addition, our advisors are versed in the impacts and changes caused by natural disasters and pandemics.

If you haven't spoken to a workplace advisor recently, we recommend having an initial conversation around your obligations under the Fair Work Act to give you peace of mind and provide assistance in need.

2. Commercial Legal advice:
